Galicia will be the first location to witness the eclipse. It will begin at 19:31, reach its maximum at  
20:28, and end at 21:22, just minutes before sunset.

# PROGRAM OUTLINE

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## Day 1:

- Accommodation at the Parador of Baiona, a castle fortress overlooking the historic town

- Visit to Pazo Pegullal: traditional Galician architecture, vineyards, camellias, and historic Galician architecture
- Afternoon visit to the town of Tui: cathedral, cobbled streets along the Minho River

## Day 3:

- Afternoon sailing in the calm waters of the Ría de Vigo to learn about and taste one of Galicia's gastronomic highlights: mussels
- Guided tour of Vigo: legends, traditions, narrow cobbled streets, and Celtic fortress with panoramic views of the city and the bay
- Evening: Verbena de San Lorenzo (traditional celebration)
- Dance with locals to traditional Galician music in a hidden village, taste authentic regional delicacies, and enjoy the magical atmosphere under the summer night sky, far from tourist crowds, where every moment tells a story.

## Day 4:

- Morning: discover the history of the area
- Afternoon: 4x4 "Ruta do Suido", eclipse viewing, luxury local gastronomy dinner under the stars on the mountain
- Evening: stargazing and the Perseids (San Lorenzo's Tears)

## Day 5:

- 4x4 excursion to the O Ribeiro mountain wine region
- Visit to the Wine Museum
- Guided tour of Ribadavia, a medieval and Jewish heritage town
